

Position: Family Practitioner

Katy Trail Community Health is seeking a Family Practitioner to work in a busy Community Health Center setting. This full time position (36 hours) will be located primarily in our Warsaw site, but will also serve our Sedalia site.

Katy Trail Community Health offers competitive salary and benefits including malpractice insurance, continuing medical education, retirement, health care and paid time off.

Physician will care for a wide range of patients including children, adults and the elderly. Most of our patients are uninsured with a significant minority on Medicaid and Medicare. A small percentage of our patients have private insurance.

Our services include

- Preventative health, including well women and children screening.
- Acute care for minor illness or injury.
- Monitoring of chronic conditions, such as diabetes, hypertension and asthma.
- Acute Mental health/counseling.
- Discount medication.
- Bi-lingual translators are available for patient assistance.
- Transportation assistance for specialty care
- After hours call and extended office hours

Salary: Based on experience

Paid Time off:
